No on Prop. 7 Campaign Responds To Field Poll: The More Voters Learn About Prop. 7, The Less They Like It

SACRAMENTO – The Field Poll today made public survey results of California voters and their position on Prop. 7 on the November ballot. Field found 39% of voters support the measure, while 43% oppose.

This is a dramatic shift from a July Field Poll of Prop. 7, when 63% of those surveyed supported the measure and 24% opposed. Californians Against Another Costly Energy Scheme, the No on Prop. 7 campaign, issued the following statement:

“The Field Poll confirms what our campaign has been saying all along: the more people learn about Proposition 7, the more likely they are to oppose this flawed and costly measure. Prop. 7 will lead to less renewable power and higher electric rates, which is why the measure is opposed by an unprecedented coalition of solar, wind and renewable power companies, environmentalists, businesses, consumer groups, utilities, seniors, organized labor and both major political parties. We’re confident voters will reject the measure on Tuesday.”
